WHO WE ARE

With over 380 members and counting, the Clean Energy Council (CEC) is the peak body representing Australia's clean energy and energy efficiency industries.

An incorporated not-for-profit national association headquartered in Melbourne, we're funded principally by membership fees and income from CEC events and activities such as industry accreditation programs.

Our member companies work in wind, hydro, wave and ocean, solar PV, solar thermal, bioenergy, solar hot water, geothermal, cogeneration and energy efficiency.

WHAT WE DO

Our primary role is to develop and advocate effective policy at the state and federal levels in order to:

- accelerate the development and deployment of all clean energy technologies
- influence the development of effective legislation and regulation to reduce energy demand and improve energy efficiency, and
- minimise cost and other barriers to accessing cleaning energy.

The CEC also promotes awareness and understanding of the industry and clean energy business opportunities through industry events, member briefings and networking functions, technical/sectoral reports and newsletters.

HOW WE WORK

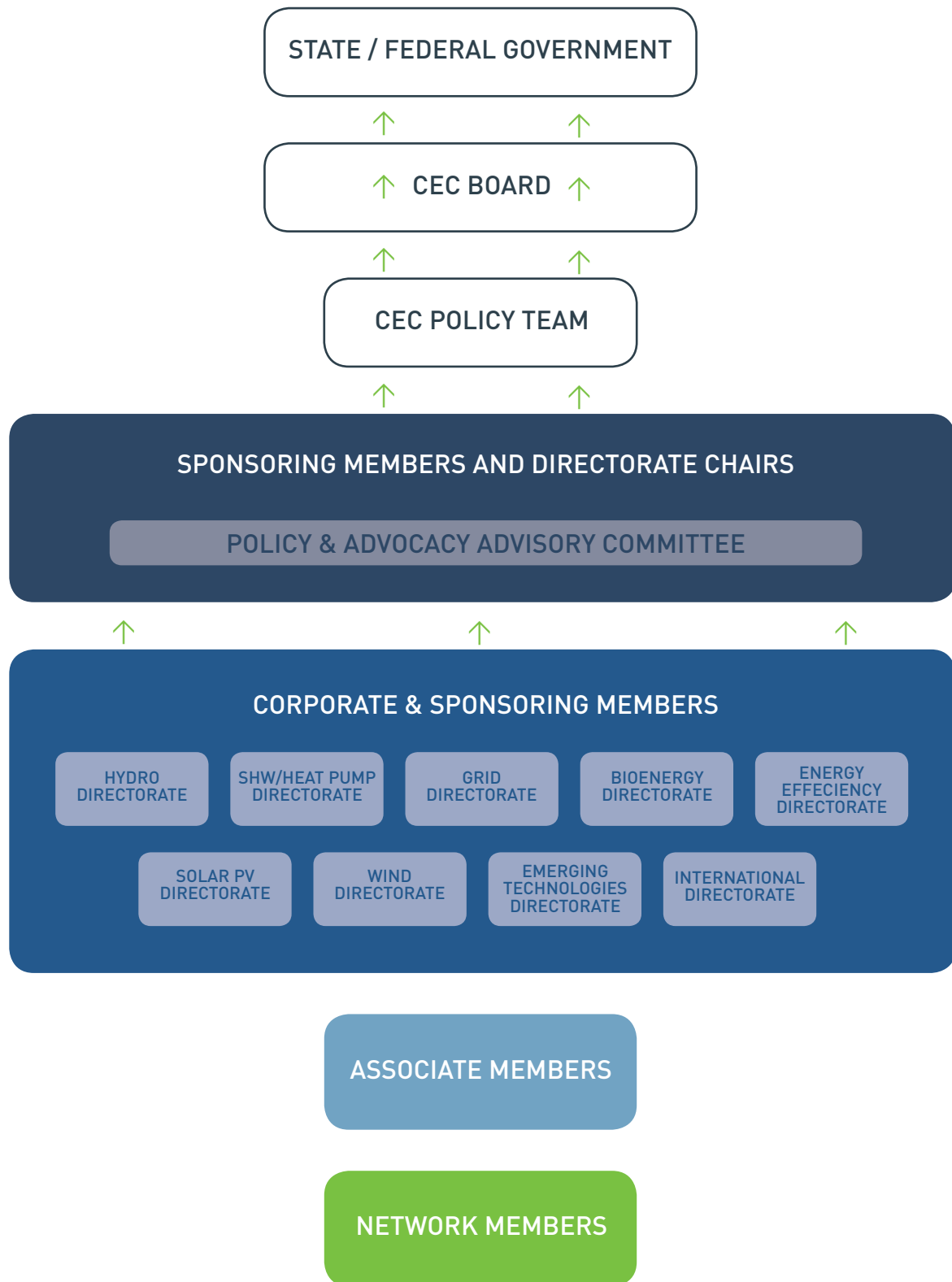
All CEC activities are reported to a 13-person board elected by our members at the Annual General Meeting. The board advises on the strategic direction and financial management of the organisation. Our policy and advocacy work is guided by a dedicated committee, comprising representatives from Sponsoring members and the chair of each of the nine CEC Directorates.

Directorates are comprised of Corporate and Sponsoring member companies who advise on policy and industry development issues in their specific sector. We have Directorates for bioenergy, emerging technologies, energy efficiency, grid, hydro, international, solar water heating/heat pump, solar PV and wind.
